This is an example of the approximate expenses you will have whilst living in Denmark.

Phone plan (calls, SMS/MMS & data)	100	15
Home Internet (if not included in rent)	100	15

Study trip (on the 2 nd semester, if any)	3500-4500	500-600
Books (depending on your programme)	1500-4500	190-620

Additional expenses

You usually pay a deposit for your dorm room (3 months' rent) when you accept an offer. If the room is not furnished, you will have to buy some furniture and kitchen utensils. You can buy this second-hand, from other students or find quite cheap things in e.g. IKEA. Flats in Denmark are usually not furnished.
